The bronze floor lamps with parchment shades are French, circa 1950. The client, designer, and art consultant blocked out this space in advance for Ellsworth Kelly's *Black Curve Diagonal*.



Nahem custom designed an upholstered headboard for the master bed, covered in Frette linens. Twilight-blue draperies are Donghia, pewter wall coverings are John Hutton Textiles, and an all-wool rug is Stark. Bedside tables, made of bleached birdside maple, are circa-1970 Carl Springer. Lucite lamps, circa 1960, are from Italy. Untitled works by David Smith hang above the bed.
